The quorum of the meeting was complete.

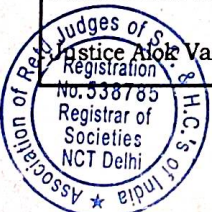
**Agenda No. 1 – Confirmation of the minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on 19.4.2025 in Karnataka Judicial Academy at Bengaluru.**

**Agenda No. 2 – Information about the new members of the Association enrolled during the year 2025-26.**

The Secretary General informed that since the last Annual General Meeting which was held on

19.04.2025 at Karnataka Judicial Academy, Bengaluru, thirty former judges joined the Association as life members. Their names were also read out by the Secretary General. **Agenda No.3-Consideration of the annual report of the activities of the association during the year 2025-26**

The Secretary General Justice Mahendra Dayal, presented the annual report informing the members about the achievements of the Association during the last financial year. It was informed by the secretary general that in the last AGM held at Bangalore on 19.4.2025, the Association published a souvenir with list of members state wise. Apart from the list of members, rules, bye-laws, important orders, list of office bearers, different forms and many more important information regarding association is printed. The souvenir was formally released by the President Justice K.L. Sharma during the last AGM and the copies of souvenir were provided free of cost to all the members.

The Secretary General also informed that the website of the Association has proved very beneficial for the members who get every information about the activities of the association including notice, agenda and minutes of the meeting with photographs. The rules and bye-laws of the association are also available on the website. The details of the office bearers with their phone numbers and pictures are available on it. The list of members state wise is also available. It was requested by the Secretary General to the members to make full use of the website.

The Secretary General also informed that in the chief Justices conference held in new Delhi few months back, the issue of providing protocol facilities to visiting former Judges of Supreme Court and High Courts was taken up as a result of sincere efforts made by the Association President Justice K.L. Sharma, but the outcome of the discussion is awaited because the minutes have not yet been released.

It was also informed that in compliance of the order passed by Supreme Court in the contempt case filed by our patron Justice V.S. Dave, most of the states have issued orders to provide allowance to the former judges equal to that of the former judges of Andhra Pradesh and it is expected that the remaining states will also issue similar orders in compliance of the order of the supreme court.

**Agenda No. 4- Consideration of the financial statement for the year 2025-26.**

The secretary general on behalf of the treasurer presented the annual financial report for the year 2025-26 and apprised the house about the assets of the association. It was informed by him that the total income of the association from the membership fee,

interest and refund of income tax was Rs. 4,47,670/-. The expenditure of the association in holding meetings, purchase of stationary, website maintenance, recharge of mobile phone and postal expenses was only Rs. 1,87,148/- and thus the association had a saving of Rs. 2,56,524/- which is more than the expenditure during the financial year.

**Agenda No.5- Consideration of budget estimates for the year 2026-27 as recommended by the Executive Committee**

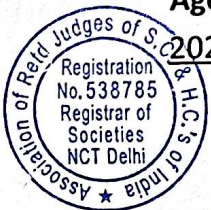
The budget estimates recommended by the executive committee were placed before the AGM and the same were unanimously approved as follows.

**Agenda No. 12-Parting messages by the President and other office bearers**



Justice K.L. Sharma outgoing President, by virtue of Association Rules 2022, will ex-officio become the patron of the Association.


